About Fr. Peter O'Sullivan SJ:

Peter was born in Farnham, Surrey, England. After graduating from university, he went to Alexandroupoulos, Greece, to teach English for two years, where he felt a call to serving communities as a priest. On returning to the UK, he contacted the Jesuits and entered the novitiate in Birmingham in 2011, taking vows two years later. As part of his Jesuit formation, he studied philosophy in Toronto, Canada and for his regency work placements, he worked at St John's Beaumont School and at St Beuno's Spirituality Centre. For theology, he was sent to Paris, where he was ordained a deacon. He is currently finishing a master's degree in contemporary church history at the Catholic University of Leuven, Belgium, while being a deacon at the two English-speaking parishes in the city.
