FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Next Sunday brings the commencement once more of our English Speaking First Holy Communion programme. During the coming weeks and months, children will meet together, and parents will be involved also, on several Sundays beginning with the 11am Mass. The emphasis of the course remains what it has been for very many years, namely, that parents and children learn together about our faith and about the importance and great blessings of that we receive in the risen Lord's Body and Blood, in the Eucharist.

Parents and carers are important in the process because you not only come to understand the place of the Eucharist in Catholic prayer and worship more effectively, but you also participate in the growth and transformation of the faith of your child as you pray, worship and learn together. Owing to the shared experience, It is very different from a course that might be taught in the primary school, and in fact the Archdiocese expects that this preparation is done within the parish and not in a school.

Our team of catechists, led by Aga, are looking forward to working with and helping the parents and the children during the coming months, including the beautiful Retreat Day in the countryside, and the wonderful Mass of First Holy Communion itself. The whole parish prays for the children, the parents, the carers, and for the catechists, that everything may go smoothly.
