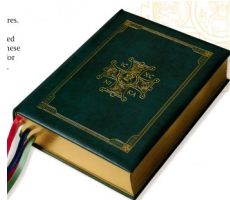

A Kingdom divided cannot stand

It was a hard truth for Jesus to learn, as recounted in our Gospel for today: he was not accepted by the people with whom he grew up, and his family thought he was “out of his mind”. They didn’t really grasp the meaning of what he was teaching, nor the full import of his actions, especially when he spent so much time with tax collectors and sinners, and made it clear that his Kingdom was “not of this world”.

While they might disown him, Jesus does not disown his family, but declares the importance of doing the will of the one who sent him. His teachings are proclaimed to foster a new family of which we become members through baptism and through following his lead in the way we live our lives, and in the way we proclaim what we believe about Jesus Christ, about his mission and about his kingdom.

For those who truly believe, the Good News is that we wish to continue to be members of his family and to proclaim our beliefs to others. For so many people the “kingdom” we presently live in seems like a troubled and hard place, with division, conflict, war, and massive levels of suffering, famine, drought and other hardships, to say nothing of the constant threats to freedom around the world.

We give thanks for the family of God who continues to inspire us through Christ to grow in faith and to develop our ministries in His Kingdom, especially through our outreach to help the poor, the unemployed, those suffering from addictions, the sick and the bereaved. May His Kingdom come!
