The charity Missio responds to the needs of displaced, homeless and poor throughout the world in response to the Our Lord's call to go out the whole world, proclaiming the Good News and bringing help, support and relief.

This year their focus is on the terrible situation in the Middle East where so many people have been killed, injured or displaced by war and terror in Lebanon, Palestine and Israel.

There are many agencies in these places using every available resource to bring help to thousands of people in dire need. Fr Rouphael, the Missio Director in Lebanon writes: "It has been three weeks since the war was declared over Lebanon. As a result, approximately one million people have been displaced from the southern region of the country. In our area alone, we have around 250,000 internally displaced people from the south. While this is a heavy load to bear, the solidarity shown towards the displaced has been remarkable. The Christians of Lebanon have truly exemplified the spirit of love and compassion for their fellow citizens. An Imam recently expressed that without the support of the Christians, the situation would have been far worse. This is a testament to the power of unity and hope in the midst of such darkness." And in the **Holy Land**: In June of this year, an estimated 90,000 Israelis and 1.9 million Palestinians were displaced because of the conflict in the area. In addition, there are a further 1.4 million refugees in refugee camps across the region. As the war rages on, missionary partners are doing all they can to keep morale and hope in their communities high and in particular to keep children learning when schools are closed.
