## November prayers for the Dead

By long-standing tradition November is the  
month when we particularly remember all  
members of our family and friends who  
have died. We pray for them that they  
rejoice with God in the bliss of eternity with  
all the saints. This week sees the  
celebration of All Saints, a Holy Day of



Obligation when we should all try to attend Mass, and, on the  
following day (Saturday) All Souls. During the evening Mass  
on Saturday we will remember in a special way all  
parishioners who have died since November 1 2023. Their  
names will be read out and we will pray for their eternal rest.  
During November we keep a Book of Remembrance by the  
large Crucifix in the church. Into this book you may add  
names of people who have died that you wish to be  
remembered during the month. The book will be placed on  
the altar at every Mass during November.

Mass on Friday is the Solemnity of All Saints. There will be a  
Vigil Mass on Thursday at 6.30pm, and the regular 10am and  
6.30pm Mass on Friday. Let us pray for the intercession and  
the encouragement of Saints—the saint whose name we  
have, our Confirmation Saint, our patron saint, and other  
saints to whom we pray for help.
