Youth Sunday

Today, the Feast of Christ, the Universal King, is the day of prayer for all of our young people. We pray that God will inspire them to prayer, to fellowship in the Church, to finding joy in their companionship to Christ, our Lord, and that they may be helped by the rest of us to engage with our worship and our ways of serving other people.

There are already young people who serve at the altar at the 9.30am and 11am Masses, and we have a wonderful group of teenagers who sing in the choir at the 9.30am Mass. Young people are also involved as servers and in the choirs for the Latin-American and the Polish Masses, and one is a gifted keyboard player and organist. Two of our parish youth help with the offertory at the morning Masses and with the tea/coffee in the hall after two of the morning Masses. One of the Confirmation candidates last year volunteered to read at the Sunday Mass, and he still appears from time to time while at University. We welcome more of our young people to volunteer to be readers.

Of special note are the young adults who volunteer with the monthly soup run and also with the Social Apostolate during the week. One of these was runner-up for the diocese-wide "Love in Action" awards this year as Young Volunteer of the Year. He is also a catechist for the teenage Confirmation Programme. We encourage as many of our young people to engage more with the parish. One area of particular need is Parish Reception (at the
