PARISH SYNOD MEETING

Thursday June 5th, from 6.30pm: Thank you to so many of you who
came to the Volunteers Morning of fellowship and prayer on Saturday
10th May. It was a wonderful sign of the talents and warm spirit in our
parish when we gather together. Now I am inviting you to come to a
meeting next month, which will be for all who want to help to develop
our parish based on our united goal for community involvement, and to
accompany one another of all age groups in our Christian faith. This
meeting will be facilitated by Br Ken Vance, SJ, who is convenor of all the
Jesuit parishes in Britain, and Danny Curtin - a facilitator who has been
involved in Jesuit parishes for some years.

As part of our journey as a parish and in harmony with the ongoing
reflections of the Synod on Synodality, we are embarking on a significant
exploration of 'accompaniment'.

Accompaniment is the central theme of the three yearly Jesuit parishes
conference in November this year, and can be described as a
life-changing approach that calls us to “walk together”—listening,
discerning, and responding to the movement of the Holy Spirit in one
another. As the late Pope Francis shared, it is the 'art of standing along-
side others,' a practice rooted in attentiveness and love that is central to
our Christian calling.

We warmly invite you to join us **Thursday June 5th, 6:30-7:30pm** in our
parish hall. Together, we will reflect on what it means to accompany
one another in our daily lives and consider how we as Pilgrims of Hope
can embrace this life-giving mission during the Jubilee Year.

envision how our Jesuit parish can offer hope and inspiration to others.

The 10th Great Haringey Deanery Walk: Monday 26th May 2025

This year, to complete the Decade between these two Holy Years, our final walk will follow the route of The Westminster Way, a special walk devised for this Holy Year visiting another six churches beginning at the English Martyrs, Tower Hill (District & Circle Line) and ending (via St Mary Moorfields, Charterhouse, St Etheldreda's and Corpus Christi, Maiden Lane) at Westminster Cathedral.
