FRIDAY: Sacred Heart of Jesus

We celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ, the remarkable mystery of the living and risen Christ in the Eucharist which he left us as his memorial and ultimate free giving of himself. We give thanks for the many blessings received as a result of the death of Christ on the Cross, and we believe that in receiving him in the Eucharist we receive also healing and strength, not only for ourselves but also for all those for whom we pray every time we celebrate Mass.

This weekend falls in the middle of the annual Sacred Heart Novena, in preparation for the celebration of the Feast of Sacred Heart this coming Friday. All are invited to join in saying the prayer at Masses today.

Novena Prayer:

Lord Jesus, you have said, 'Ask and you shall receive, seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you'.

I come to you in faith and trust, in love and hope.

Let me know your closeness to me, and your care for me and all who are dear to me.

My intention for this Novena is dear to me, and I know that what is important to me is important to you.

grant what I ask, and may I always trust that in all that happens in life, you will be close to me as my friend, guide and saviour. And so, Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.
