Third Sunday of Easter - Jesuit Missions Appeal

On this Third Sunday of Easter, the Gospel invites us to walk alongside the disciples on the road to Emmaus - confused, discouraged, and yet unknowingly in the presence of the risen Lord. It's in the simple acts of journeying together, listening to the Word, and the breaking of bread that their eyes are opened and their hearts set ablaze.

This same quiet, transformative presence of Christ continues in our world today, often in places that can seem distant or forgotten. As we welcome the Jesuit Mission appeal this weekend, we're reminded that the Risen Lord walks closely with indigenous communities along the border with Brazil, communities who, for over a century, have been accompanied by Jesuits in faith, dignity, and hope.

The focus on bilingual education for indigenous children - the centre of the appeal - is not just about language; it's about identity, belonging, and the affirmation that every culture is a gift. Just as the disciples came to recognise Christ speaking their own story back to them, so too these children are empowered when their own language and heritage are honoured alongside new opportunities for learning.

Easter faith is never passive. The encounter with the risen Christ sends us out to recognise Him in others, to listen more deeply, and to act with compassion. Supporting this mission is one way we take part in that journey, helping to ensure that Christ's light continues to be recognised and received in every culture and community.

May our hearts burn within us this Easter season, and may we, like those first disciples, become witnesses of hope in our world.
